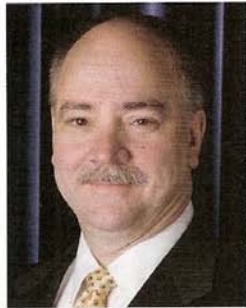

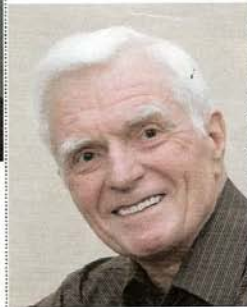
**James V. Kelly**
