


The schedule for the Secret Snowflake Activity is as follows:



Weeks of 12/1 & 12/6- find out who your Secret Snowflake is. Remember to keep it a secret. They will try to guess who you are. At each session, you can leave a secret note for your Secret Snowflake. (Envelopes will be set up along the windows in the tutoring center). You can give them a hint about who you are. (For example, I am ___ years old. I like to read about _____. etc). Someone will leave you a note too. Read your note with your tutor and try to guess who is writing to you.

Week of 12/13- Create a Snowflake Craft as a gift for your Secret Snowflake. (We will provide all the supplies. We will also provide art materials for you to make a card).



Week of 12/20- Leave your gift and card for your Secret Snowflake. Make sure you write who it is for and who you are- the secret is out this week- everyone will find out who their Secret Snowflake is. (Remember that we are closed from 12/24 through 1/2 so make sure you leave your gift before then).






STUDENT SPOTLIGHT: AVIA
